

## Non-Custodial Parent Release

To enable Granville Christian Academy to comply with legal agreements and with the custodial parent's wishes, please provide the following information. Ohio Revised Code 3319.321 (B) (5) states: The non-custodial parent is entitled to have access to records pertaining to his or her child to the same extent that such access is provided to the custodial parent, unless otherwise provided in the separation agreement, divorce decree, or court order. The burden is on the custodial parent to inform the school of any such limitations.

It is the custodial parent's responsibility to communicate the information provided on this form to the noncustodial parent. If no instructions are given, the school will contact the Granville Police Department.

You must provide a copy of the legal documents that support your custodial arrangements.
